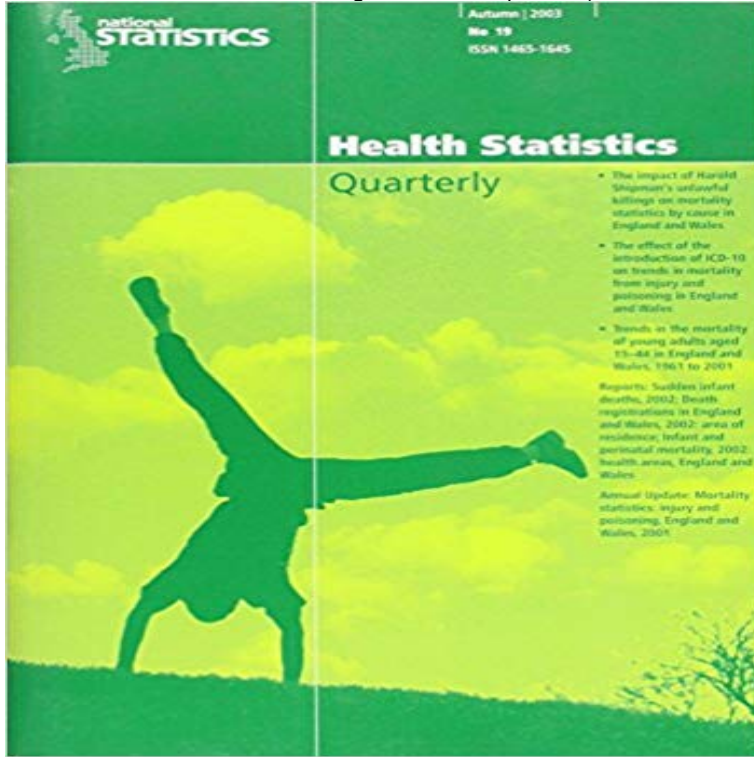


Health Statistics Quarterly 19, Autumn 2003
