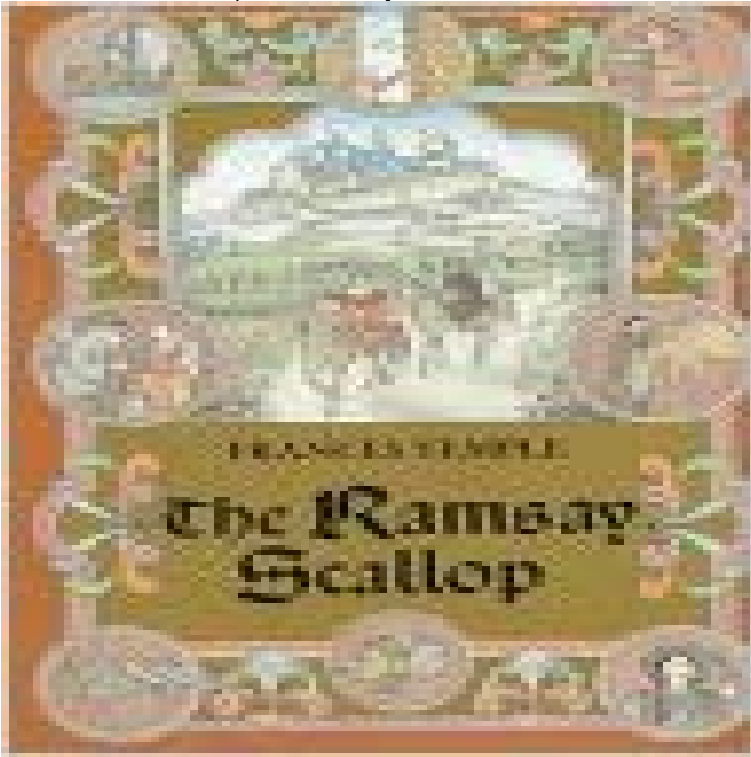


The Ramsay Scallop
